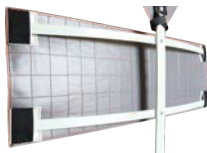

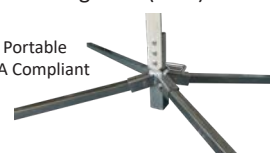

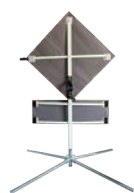
#### New Compliant Base Option

### Set up Instructions



- Place the MKL Folding Base on the ground. Add optional sandbag. Assemble the Flexi-Kit Upright and insert into the base.
- Position the braces as per the photo. Insert the braces into the pockets on the rear of the signs.
- Fasten the velcro strap at the bottom of the diamond around the upright.
- To take down, simply reverse the procedure.
