PROCESS

Setting up the actual speed display (Fig1-Fig4)

This allows you to show the oncoming traffic the ACTUAL speed they are travelling.

- In JAMLOGIC right click on the trailer in the DEVICE LIST and select MESSAGE EDITOR
- Message Editor screen will pop up as in Fig.1
- Next you need to select **A SPECIAL TAG** do this by clicking on the top taskbar.
- SPECIAL TAG SCREEN will pop up; refer Fig.2 You will need to select radar > KM/H > Insert



- There are three message lines and wherever you place your cursor is where the TAG will be inserted
- Fig.4 6 are examples of TAG and MESSAGE positioning



Next, we are going to set the OVERSPEED mgs – this message will display when a driver exceeds your chosen speed zone limit



- Continuing from what we set up above YOUR SPEED 105
- Select another page > (to the left in top taskbar)
- Select page condition > (to the middle in top taskbar)
- PAGE CONDITION window will pop up > set your speed range 1 km/h your work zone speed, e.g. 0-31Km/h > Apply



You can add a message in the lines below the "0".





- PAGE CONDITION window will pop up > ENABLE



 Select speed range higher than what the Zone is set at – e.g. If your zone is a 70km/hr zone – select 71km (Fig.7)


